Following on from the AGM after the Golden Jubilee, Mr Bruce Jenkins became Chairman, Mr Peter Pinnell Vice Chairman, Mr Gerard Robinson Secretary and Mr Dirk Joubert Treasurer. The committee comprised of Mesdames Irma Lowman, Peggy Pinnell, Pat Sonnenschein, Matty Hartley, Sue Duff, Claire Paine, Suzanne Scott and Messrs Mike Paine, Ron Kaser, Ronnie Lessing, Kobus Reyneke, Allan Duff, F'Tiaan De Wit, Vonk Cordier. As of 2016 the only remaining committee members are Mr Bruce Jenkins and Mrs Pat Sonnenschein.



Mr Gerard Robinson became editor of Dachs Yap and gave it a great upgrade; at that stage we did four issues a year. It was a big job remembering that there was no internet therefore the postal service was the only way of communicating with members. Speaking of which, Messrs Gerard Robinson and Dirk Joubert undertook a huge marketing campaign getting names of people who had registered and done transfers with KUSA and sending out hundreds of letters and membership applications. This paid off handsomely and a lot of new members were enrolled.

As time went by Messrs Robinson and Joubert resigned due to pressure at work, Mr Kobus Reyneke became secretary and Mr F'Tiaan De Wit Treasurer. Mrs Pat Sonnenschein took over as Dachs Yap editor. Various changes took place on the committee, both Messrs Reyneke and De Wit were deceased far too early and Mrs Pat Sonnenschein stepped in as Secretary and served in this position until 2014 when Mrs Sarah Rose took over as Secretary. After the demise of Mr De Wit, Miss Ashleigh Feeny took over the responsibility as Treasurer. Mrs Pat Sonnenschein handed the duties of Dachs Yap over to Mrs K de Klerk as editor and in 2014 Miss Ashleigh Feeny subsequently took over the position as editor of the magazine.



With the introduction of the internet Mr Greg Cook designed and introduced the Club's first web page. Over the years upgrades have been done by Miss Sonelle van Wyk and is now in the hands of Mrs Viv Fuidge, who is maintaining and upgrading the web page on a constant basis.

With email becoming the way of communication, we decided to drop the magazine down to 2 issues per year and to introduce the E-News, which is still sent out every second month. With postal deliveries having become unreliable and soaring printing costs we are unfortunately have to reduce

the Dachs Yap magazine to one a year. This said, the magazine will now have more pages and information than before.

As the popularity of Facebook is growing on a daily basis, we now have a very active page (**The South African Dachshund Club**), which is not only for members but for the general public as well, so that we can spread the word on various Dachshund related issues.



Over the years we had brief ventures into various activities, one of them being Earth dog trials which we were unable to continue. However, by popular demand we are now exhibiting at the World of Dogs and Cats (WODAC) every alternate year and hold a fun day every year in mid-June for club members and the general public to raise funds for needy Dachshunds.

When KUSA joined the FCI we were with KUSA wanting to change our breed standards to those of the FCI. As a result of this we mustered some 170 objections from members and instead of country of origin (Germany), to this day we follow the breed standard of the country of Patronage i.e. the UK breed standard with the exception of FCI shows where obviously the FCI standard is used.



Due to the increased popularity of the Dachshund we were suddenly faced with the dreaded puppy farmers who at this time are still a major concern. Rescue numbers soared and the Club was unable to cope. Thankfully, we now have a number of rescue organisations who handle all rescues that were not bred by club members thus lightening our load considerably. Annually the Club raises funds for one of these organisations (**The Dachshund Haven**) to assist these wonderful people with their work.

This also highlighted the colour issue with the introduction of the dapple, cream and brindle. Many of our breed are being incorrectly registered. As per the breed standard there are only 3 base colours, namely; **RED, BLACK AND TAN** and **CHOCOLATE AND TAN**. Other colours such as brown, biscuit, silver etc. are not recognised colours.
